1. INTRODUCTION

Web accessibility consists in designing digital content that can be used by everyone, including users with visual, auditory, motor, speech, cognitive, neurological disabilities or combinations thereof. **In line with the four principles of WCAG 2.2 – Web Content Accessibility Guidelines (perceivable, operable, understandable and robust), the goal is to create an inclusive experience that ensures all persons can interact with online content** effectively and independently, on any device: desktop, mobile or assistive.

Accessibility also contributes to better overall usability for all users, for example the elderly, users with slow connections, outdated devices or alternative browsers.

Rothoblaas recognises the value of accessibility as a social responsibility and as a fundamental technical requirement for the quality of its own website. We are committed to respecting the criteria set out by the regulations in force, including:

- WCAG 2.2, official W3C recommendation;
- Law 4/2004 ("Legge Stanca") and AgID guidelines (for Italy);
- any other relevant European or international standards.

This statement reflects the current accessibility status of the website **www.rothoblaas.com** and our continued efforts to improve it.

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2. CONFORMITY STATUS

The website www.rothoblaas.com is currently:

☒ **Partially compliant** with the **Web Content Accessibility Guidelines (WCAG) 2.2 W3C Recommendation 12 December 2024**, level **AA**.

Reason: The website is partially compliant with the **WCAG 2.2 level AA requirements due to the presence of certain elements that are not fully accessible, in particular UI components with inadequate contrast, lack of non-text content for certain images and the absence of visible focus in certain contexts. These issues were identified in a recent UX/UI technical analysis and are currently being addressed.**

4. MEASURES FOR IMPROVEMENT

To improve website accessibility, Rothoblaas has launched an action plan that includes:

- Full accessibility technical audit by **December 2025**
- Updating of non-compliant templates and UI components through the **Design System**
- Review of colour contrast, typography and content hierarchy
- Correct insertion of alt attributes and form field labels
- Ongoing training for design, development and content teams
- Monitoring with automatic tools (e.g. WAVE) and manual testing with assistive technologies (e.g. screen readers)

Expected timeframe for completion of actions: end of 2026
